


WHAT YOU NEED

A Wall With Studs

The Feline Frame can be installed on any wall that has study at 16"centers.

What In The Heck Are Studs???

Studs are vertical support boards behind your wall usually spaced 16"apart. You will need to find the approximate center of studs. You can use a stud finder or you can find the approximate center manually. If you are not sure how to do this then Google it – or, hire a professional.



Be Careful!

The studs behind some walls may not be consistently 16" apart throughout the length of the wall. This means that the studs you intend to use to anchor the Step Shelves may not be where expected. So, confirm the locations of all the studs you intend to use for the Step Shelves before attaching the Frame Ensemble.

ACHIEVING THE BEST EFFECT


Location, Location

Choose a suitable location for your Feline Frame Ensemble which is 18" high and 23" wide. Each Frame Shelf must be secured at 2 adjacent stud locations.

IMPORTANT:

To ensure safety, we advise against installing your Feline Frame Ensemble above a baby crib, playpen, bed headboard or other similar locations.



The super cool effect of seeing your cat in the artwork is best enjoyed when the center of the Feline Frame is at, or near, eye level. So pick a place where you can install the Feline Frame to achieve this effect.

YOUR CAT'S ACCESS TO THE FELINE FRAME


How's Your Cat Gonna' Get Up There?

Now that you picked the best spot where to install the Feline Frame, ask yourself how your cat will get up there. Unless your cat wears a cape and can leap a tall building in a single bound, you need a way for your paw-riffic friend to access the Feline Frame.




OPTION A) Access Via Room Items


Do you have items along the wall that will facilitate the cat's ability to get up there (like a sofa that's next to a book shelf - that leads to the Feline Frame)?



OPTION B) Access Via Feline Step Shelves


Or, do you need our fancy carpeted Feline Step Shelves? You can purchase our Feline Step Shelves at FrameYourFeline.com. If this method is how your cat is going to access the Feline Frame then BE SURE to choose a location that will allow for at least 2 step shelves. So, approximately an additional 3 to 5 1/2 feet is required on either side of your Feline Fame for these steps. Each Feline Step Shelf is 21" long and must also be secured at 2 adjacent stud locations. A variety of suggested Feline Step Shelf configurations are listed in "Instruction Set #3: Feline Step Shelves Installation Instructions" or on our website at FrameYourFeline.com











Where to Place the Feline Step Shelves?

If you don't have any preconceived plan for your Feline Step Shelf arrangement, we have included in the printed instructions and on our website five Feline Step Shelf configurations with specific placement dimensions. **These configurations are only suggestions** but will serve to provide a functional Feline Step Shelf arrangement within your available wall space.






Space Out for One Cat


If you have only one furry feline friend whose going solo then take a look at "Option #1" and "Option #2".

OPTION #1: LIMITED WALL SPACE

Utilize "Configuration A" or "Configuration B" if you have very limited wall space but at least 3 feet on either side of your Feline Frame.













OPTION #2: Great Wall Space

"Configuration C" or "Configuration D" may be preferred if you have greater wall space with at least 5 ½' on either side of your Feline Frame.












Space Out for Multiple Cats

Cats LOVE to jump, climb and hang-out for extended periods of time on the Feline Step Shelves and the Feline Frame. If you have more than one furry feline friend then we suggest you install 3 Feline Step Shelves to avoid traffic jams. This enables your cats to enter or exit from either side of the Feline Frame. Utilize "Configuration E" if you have at least 3' on both sides of your Feline Frame.

THE CHECKLIST BEFORE INSTALLATION

Before You Install Your Feline Frame...

Let's be sure you have everything figured out. Let's go through the check list below!

I know what studs are and I know how to find them.			
I will be installing on a wall with studs at 16 inch centers.			
I have all the required tools needed (see Page 2).			
I have selected an area to install the feline frame where the center of the frame is at, or near, eye level.			
I know how my cat will access the Feline Frame:			
Via Room Items (If selected then you are done with this checklist. Proceed to "Instruction Set #2: Feline Frame Installation Instructions") Via Feline Step Shelves			
I will be installing Feline Step Shelves and have chosen the following shelf placement option that works best for my space (see Pages 6-8):			
Configuration A: "Short Left"			
Configuration B: "Short Right"			
Configuration C: "Long Left"			
Configuration D: "Long Right"			
Configuration E: "The Roundabout"
